Record Show Payoff Triggered By Faltering Favorite

Shakopee, MN -- The opening race on Sunday set a new Canterbury Park record. It wasn't on the track however; it was in the pari-mutuel payoffs. Yappah Do was sent to post as the favorite at win odds of 3 to 10. More than 96% of the total \$52,505 show pool was wagered on the 3-year-old Minnesota bred colt. After racing in second for a half-mile, Yappah Do faded and finished fifth, beaten by 12 lengths.

With the favorite out-of-money, third place finisher Turtle Mountain returned \$122.00 for a \$2 show wager. In fact, all show payoffs on the top three finishers exceeded the previous record, set July 10, 1999, of \$37.60. The winner, Sahan, paid \$42.20 to show and second-place finisher B. B. Hill returned \$68.20.

The Canterbury mutuels department reported that \$37,000 was wagered into the show pool through the TVG wagering hub in California.
