Time for Wilena Wins \$35,300 Canterbury Park Quarter Horse Derby

Filly Wins at 30-1, Equals Track Record

Shakopee, MN -- Time for Wilena, a 30-1 long shot, regained her top form while defeating eight three-year-olds in the \$35,300 Canterbury Quarter Horse Derby on Saturday at Canterbury Park. Nik Goodwin rode the Texas bred filly to victory for trainer Brent Clay and owner John L. Herrick. Time for Wilena now has two wins from four lifetime starts and has increased her earnings to \$29,666. Time for Wilena completed the 400 yards in a 19.69, equaling the track record and winning by a neck over The Regal Streak.

"This filly is getting better all the time. It wasn't a big surprise. I thought I had four live runners in here," Clay said.

Time for Wilena paid \$63.80 to win. "I galloped two of them the other day and Brent gave me a choice of which one to ride. I went with the one that I thought had the most upside," Goodwin said.

The Regal Streak, also trained by Clay, was ridden by Scott Stevens. Strawkinson was third and was ridden by Jerry Vaughan.
