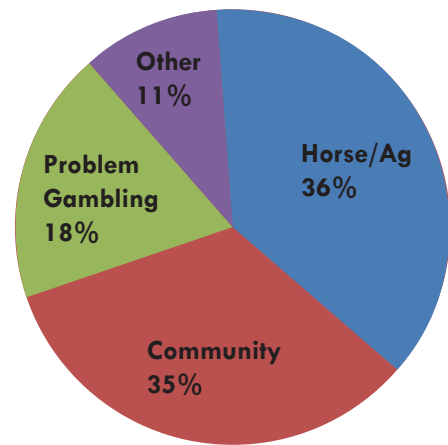

# CANTERBURY PARK MINNESOTA FUND GRANTS - \$54,900



## LOCAL ORGANIZATION GRANTS

### American Cancer Society - \$2,500

Granted to the Scott County Relay for Life event that benefits cancer patients and survivors. Canterbury continues their annual sponsorship of this event.

### Special Olympics - \$2,500

For sponsorship of the Polar Plunge event that provides support to programs associated with the Special Olympics.

### Lions Park Fun for All Playground - \$5,000

This grant will help build an all inclusive playground at Lions Park in Shakopee. This is a multiple year grant and will be paid out at \$5,000 a year over 4 years.

### Shakopee Community Assistance - \$1,200

The grant was used as a one year supplement to the existing emergency food shelf. This organization is committed to meeting the basic needs of clothing, nutrition and hygiene for children and families with limited resources.

### Scott County Historical Society - \$2,450

For support of the Tourism Exhibit in which Canterbury Park is a featured business.

### Shakopee Educational Endowment Foundation - \$1,000

This grant helps to fund items not covered in the annual Shakopee schools budget.

### PACER Center - \$1,000

This grant will be used for the 'Kids Against Bullying' program that is presented at Shakopee elementary schools.

### Loaves and Fishes - \$1,000

This local organization serves hot meals to those in need in the Shakopee/Scott County area.

### Esperanza - \$2,500

Esperanza provides hope for those in need in our community. The grant will be used to provide breakfast and lunch for children over the summer months when school meals are not offered.

### Law Enforcement Officers Memorial Scholarship of Scott County - \$250

This grant will be used to provide annual scholarships for local residents attending school and preparing for a career in law enforcement.

## EQUINE ORGANIZATION GRANTS

### Freedom Farm - \$1,000

This grant was used for sponsorship of the 2016 Polo event.

### Majestic Hills Ranch Foundation - \$2,500

This grant was used for the continuation of the 2016 Veterans program.

### We Can Ride - \$1,000

This grant was used to purchase hay/feed for one horse, for one year, in the therapeutic riding program.

### Bowman's Second Chance Thoroughbred Adoption - \$15,212

Second Chance Thoroughbred Adoption actively takes retired race horses from the track and works to rehabilitate them for life after racing.

### Minnesota Quality of Life - \$10,000

This grant will be used to provide chemical dependency services to the backside population at Canterbury Park.

### Permanently Disabled Jockeys Fund, Inc. - \$6,000

This organization provides financial assistance to former jockey's that have suffered catastrophic on track injuries. This grant will go to help support those jockey's.

## PROBLEM GAMING

### Northstar Problem Gambling Alliance - \$5,000

Canterbury Park also supports the Northstar Problem Gambling Alliance by being a major sponsor in various fundraisers.

### Project Turnabout - \$5,000

The grant will support Project Turnabout's Patient Aid Fund. This fund was established for patients/families that don't have the financial means to cover treatment costs.
