## PLAYER OF THE SERIES AWARDS

A non-transferable 2019 \$1,100 Championship Main Event Entry will be awarded to the player earning the most points in each event pool category.

### Top Player of the Daytime Events:

Includes Daytime Events #2-18,  
Excludes Events #1, #4, #13, #19 and all satellites.

### Top Player of the Bonus Events:

Includes 6 PM Bonus Events Oct. 5-14th

## POINT STRUCTURE

- Points awarded based on placement in each event and calculated separately in each of the two event pools.
- Points awarded to the top 21 players finishing "in the money" in each event. If an event does not pay 21 places only those players awarded prize pool payouts receive points.
- Players not finishing in the "in the money" or not placing in the top 21 earn 1 pint per entry.
- Any money deals must be made in public, with the approval of the Tournament Director.
- In the event of a money deal placement will be awarded based on total prize money awarded with highest placement and points going to the highest amount of prize money earned. In the event of even chops placement will be awarded based on chip count at the time of chop. Points cannot be chopped.
- Tiebreaker: 1) Most 1st place finishes, 2) Most finishes "in the money", 3) Total prize money earned.
- Player of the Series Awards are NOT funded from any Fall Poker Classic event prize pools.
