

Ultimate NHC Satellite Handicapping Contest Sunday, May 19, 2019

The Contest:

The Ultimate Satellite Handicapping Contest on Sunday, May 19 will qualify players to the Canterbury Ultimate NHC Qualifier on Sept. 6. The contest will begin no earlier than 1:00 p.m. Each player will pay a non-refundable \$50 entry fee. One player for each 11 entries from the satellite will win a \$550 entry to the Canterbury Ultimate NHC Qualifier to be held Sept. 6.

Entry Fee: \$50.

Format: Each entrant will receive a mythical \$400 bankroll. Entrants **must** wager at least one-half of existing mythical bankroll on each of five designated races on May 19. Satellite Contest times and races will be designated the day prior to the satellite.

Prize structure:

Winners will be determined by final mythical bankroll.

- One player for each 11 entries from the satellite will win a \$550 entry to the Canterbury Ultimate NHC Qualifier to be held Sept. 6.

If there are 10-21 players, one player will win a \$550 entry. Entry fees exceeding the first \$550 will be paid as prize money to the second place finisher. If there are 22-32 players, two players will win \$550 entries and the additional entry fees will be paid as prize money to the third place finisher. For example, if there are 14 entries there will be one winner that will receive the \$550 entry and the additional \$150 will be paid to the second place finisher as prize money.

Wagering Format:

- Five contest races will be designated. The specific contest races will be announced the day prior to the contest. Contest start time will not be prior to 1:00 p.m.
- Players must place mythical wagers on all five contest races.
- Each player must bet at least half of his/her current mythical bankroll on each race. Example: first contest race total bet must be at least \$200 (half of \$400 starting mythical bankroll). If player cashes that race for \$2,500 making his/her current mythical bankroll \$2,700, the next contest race wager must be at least \$1,350.
- Any bet offered WITHIN any of the races is allowed.
- Any combination of bets can be made: win, place, show, exacta, trifecta, superfecta, hi5.
- No multi race wagers ie pick 3s, pick 4s, pick 5s or daily doubles.
- Players must bet all five contest races, and **each race bet, the total MUST be at least half the current mythical bankroll** or they will be disqualified. Players may wager more than half of the existing bankroll.
- In the event of a scratch after the player has wagered: all scratched monies will be refunded after the race is official and the player's bet will be counted as a race wagered on, even if the scratch brings the player's total below the mandatory half bankroll wager.

In the event of a tie for any prize (other than cash) a coin toss will decide the outcome.

To enter:

Entries may be submitted on May 19, 2019. **A maximum of four entries per player is allowed.**

Entries and deadlines:

Entries close prior to the start of the first contest race.

All players must enter in person.

Each participant will be given an account-wagering card with which they will make their contest wagers. All tournament wagers will be made at self-service wagering machines.

Participants must be at least 21 years of age by January 1, 2020.

Players must place all wagers personally. No person shall directly or indirectly act as an intermediary, transmitter or agent in placing wagers for the player, unless authorized by Canterbury Park tournament officials.

Official payouts determined through the tote system will be used. There are no caps on the payouts for tournament purposes.

All contest wagers will be placed using the account wagering cards at self-service machines only.

Any entrant found to have not made the required contest wagers will be disqualified from the tournament. All contest wagers will be tracked by Canterbury staff. Canterbury Park contest officials will verify that all required wagers have been made before declaring the winner. When the account card is placed in a self-service machine it will show the player's current bankroll.

It is suggested that players make their wagers early to avoid being shut out of the race. It is the player's responsibility to make wagers in a timely fashion and to wager at least half of the existing bankroll.

Contest standings will be posted as the contest progresses.

Wagering structure:

Players must wager at least one-half of their existing mythical bankroll each contest race. The first contest wager will total no less than \$200. The minimum amount of the second contest wager will depend on the existing bankroll after first contest wager is official. In all cases the wager must total at least one-half of the existing bankroll.

If a bankroll totals an uneven number or is not an exact dollar amount, the bankroll will be rounded up to the nearest even-numbered dollar amount and at least half that amount will be the

required wager for the next race. For example if a bankroll is \$25 the amount of the contest wager will be at least \$13 (\$25 rounded up to \$26 and divided in half).

- There are no caps on payouts in this tournament.
- The contest winners will be determined by total bankrolls.
- All wagers will be audited at conclusion of tournament to verify winners.
- See rules regarding scratches above.
- All playing and betting disputes will be resolved by Canterbury Park officials.

Electronic failure.

In the event of electronic failure, including transmitting of pools, failure of transmission lines, or other unforeseen technical problems, wagers will be treated according to the Minnesota Racing Commission rules.

Requirements of Players:

Players must be at least 21 years of age by January 1, 2020.

Ineligibility:

The following people are ineligible to play: Employees of United Tote and the NTRA. Any person forbidden to wager on horse races at Canterbury Park.

Publicity:

By entering, winners agree to the use of their names and/or likenesses for publicity and promotional purposes without additional compensation.

Cancellation of tournament:

Canterbury Park management reserves the right to cancel the contest for any reason at any time. Canterbury Park assumes no liability for any unforeseen occurrence during the tournament. Canterbury Park reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions regarding the tournament, without claim for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions regarding the tournament, which are not specifically listed under these rules will be decided by the Canterbury Marketing Department. Those decisions will be final.

Handicapper of the Year Points: winner: 3 points; 2nd: 2 points 3rd: 1 point.
