INCIDENTS/INQUIRIES/OBJECTIONS:

Race 1- #3 "Angel's Magic", even-money favorite in the first 2-year-old race of the meet, hesitated slightly at the break but never threatened. #2 "North Arm Bay", moved #5 2 paths out nearing the 1/16th pole and #2 and #5 brushed lightly.

Race 2- #5 "Unleash The Beast" broke slightly in the air to be last in the first few strides and failed to be in a prominent position early, moved gradually to the leaders under jockey Luis Negron who moved #5 to the lead at the 1/4 pole and opened a daylight advantage to the wire.

Race 3- Program change: #3 "Direct Action" is a gelding. #1 "Shaq's My Daddy" lost Jockey Alfredo Juarez Jr. warming up on the first turn, #7 "Nu Nu" broke outward at the start. #3 "Direct Action" and #4 "Overseas

Letter" bumped lightly 2 times shortly after the start.

Race 5- 1 of 7 claims voided- No race number on envelope. Soon after the start #7 "Yo Y Me" came out lightly bumping #8 "Flash Attack" which followed #7 inward as #5 "Tick Tack Mo" bore out putting #6 "Nice Work" in a squeeze play. #6 bumped right hind quarters of #5 which turned him outward before the 5,6,7,8 separated themselves. #2 "Please the Court" was trapped behind #1 "Forgetaboutme" leaving the 1/4th pole with horses to the outside of #2 which caused Jockey Luis Negron to take a strong hold of #2 until an opening developed along the rail and #2 went onto win.

Race 7- #4 "Cinco Catalina" broke outward into #5 "Show Business".

Race 8- #4 "Sailing Along" and #7 "Binding Time" finished in a win dead-heat.

Race 9- #2 "Runamonk" drifted out first half of race. #6 "Caboose On the Loose" broke outward. #9 "Avery's Rocket" hopped at the start.


Race 10- #1 "Lady Capo" broke like a shot. #2 "Karls Dirt Surfin" broke slowly then ducked behind #1 towards the rail. #1 broke out late stretch floating #3 "Pappy Boyington" and #4 "Beyond the Boundry" wider.
