

Canterbury Park BCBC Big Ten Satellite Handicapping Contest
Saturday, September 10, 2022

The tournament:

The Canterbury Park BCBC Big Ten Satellite Handicapping Contest is a one-day handicapping contest held at Canterbury Park, Shakopee, Minn. Saturday, Sept. 10, 2022. Winner(s) will be awarded a \$3,000 entry to the Sept. 15 Canterbury Park BCBC Big Ten Contest.

Total cost per entry is \$100.

One player for each 30 entries will win a Sept. 15 Big Ten entry.

Format:

Players will select one horse in each Canterbury Park **thoroughbred race** and will earn points based on a mythical \$20 across the board wager. Entries, with all selections, must be submitted prior to the first contest race. No changes are permitted after the contest begins.

Points are capped as follows: 600 win; 400 place; 200 show. All selections must be submitted prior to post time of the first contest race. Entrants will receive the post time favorite should a scratch occur. The player with the most points at the conclusion of the contest will win the \$3,000 entry. Additional winners will be determined by score.

Cash from additional entry fees not included in assigned value of Sept. 15 berths will be paid as follows:

1st) 50 percent

2nd) 30 percent

3rd) 15 percent

4th) 5 percent

To enter:

Entries may be submitted on Sept. 10 beginning at 10:00 a.m.

No player may have more than eight entries.

Registrations and deadlines:

No entries accepted after contest begins which is estimated to be 5 p.m.

Players may have a maximum of eight entries.

Should there be a tie for Sept. 15 entry, the winner will be player selecting the most first-place horses. If a tie still exists, the winner will be the player selecting the most second-place horses. If a tie still exists then the winner will be the player selecting the most third-place horses. A coin toss would determine the winner if a tie still exists.

Requirements of Players:

Entrants must be 18 or older.

Ineligibility:

The following people are ineligible to play: Any person forbidden to play the horses at Canterbury Park.

Cancellation of tournament:

Canterbury Park management reserves the right to cancel the contest for any reason at any time.

Canterbury Park assumes no liability for any unforeseen occurrence during the contest.

Canterbury Park reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions regarding the contest, without claim for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions regarding the contest, which are not specifically listed under these rules will be decided by Canterbury Management. Those decisions will be final.

Canterbury Handicapper of the Year Points: winner: 3 points; 2nd: 2 points; 3rd: 1 point
