



# **Local Organization Grants**

# American Cancer Society - \$1,000

Granted to the Scott County Relay for Life event that benefits cancer patients and survivors. Canterbury continues their annual sponsorship of this event.

### Special Olympics - \$2,500

For sponsorship of the Polar Plunge event that provides support to programs associated with the Special Olympics.

### Lions Park Fun for All Playground - \$5,000

This grant will help build an all inclusive playground at Lions Park in Shakopee. This is a multiple year grant and will be paid out at \$5,000 a year over 4 years.

### Shakopee Educational Endowment Foundation -\$1,000

This grant helps to fund items not covered in the annual Shakopee schools budget.

### Saints Foundation - \$5,000

This sponsorship was used for general support for the Saints Foundation, formerly known as the Saints Healthcare Foundation.
