2023 Road to Kentucky Grand Prize Contest Saturday, May 27, 2023

The Contest:

The 2023 Road to Kentucky Grand Prize Contest will qualify two players for the 2023 Dog Days of Summer Handicapping Contest to be held at Canterbury Park in September. This Grand Prize contest will be held Saturday, May 27, 2023. Entry to the contest is possible only by qualifying through the free-to-enter Road to Kentucky Handicapping Contest held Saturdays at Canterbury Park, January 21 through May 6, 2023. No other entries to this contest will be allowed.

Format:

Players will select one horse in each of the 10 designated contest races and will earn points based on a mythical \$20 across the board wager. Entries, with all selections, must be submitted prior to the first contest race. No changes are permitted after the contest begins.

Players will designate one of the 10 contest races as a Double Point race and any points earned in that designated race will be doubled.

Points are capped as follows: 600 win; 400 place; 200 show. (or 1200, 800, 400 in the designated double-point race) All selections must be submitted prior to post time of the first contest race. Entrants will receive the post time favorite should a scratch occur.

The two players with the highest scores following the final contest race will receive entry to the 2023 Dog Days of Summer Handicapping Contest.

To enter:

Entry to the contest is possible only by qualifying through the free-to-enter Road to Kentucky Handicapping Contest held Saturdays at Canterbury Park, January 21 through May 6, 2023. No other entries to this contest will be allowed.

Registration:

Those that have qualified for this contest must check-in at the 3rd floor MVP Rewards desk to receive entry form. Contest will begin no earlier than noon central. on May 27.

Official contest forms will be distributed at the 3rd floor contest headquarters. Entrants must submit contest selections to that location prior to post time of the first contest race. No exceptions.

If a scratch occurs involving a contest selection, the entrant may **not** change the selection; instead the wagering favorite will be substituted.

Requirements of Players:

Entrants must be 18 or older and must have qualified through the free-to-enter Road to Kentucky Handicapping Contest held Saturdays at Canterbury Park, January 21 through May 6, 2023.

Ineligibility:

The following people are ineligible to play: Any person forbidden to play the horses at Canterbury Park. Anyone under the age of 18. Only players that have qualified per the rules are eligible.

Winner must be present at Canterbury Park at the Dog Days of Summer Contest to redeem prize.

Ties:

In the event that there is a tie between two or more players for the prize, the tied players will return for a playoff on a mutually agreed upon date to determine the winner.

Publicity:
