

Spring Tune-Up Satellite Handicapping Contest
Saturday, March 25, 2023

The tournament:

The Spring Tune-Up Satellite Handicapping Contest is a one-day handicapping contest held at Canterbury Park, Shakopee, Minn. Saturday, March 25, 2023.

Total cost per entry is \$140 of which \$100 is entry fee and \$40 is live bankroll.

Players will make a total of 10 \$2 win/place wagers using the \$40 bankroll during the contest. A list of eligible tracks and races will be made available in advance. There are no price caps. Remaining bankrolls will be returned at contest conclusion.

All wagers will be made at self-service wagering machines using an account wagering card provided at time of entry. Players can begin placing selections upon registering.

The contest will end at approximately 5:30pm.

A maximum of FOUR entries per person is allowed.

Order of contest finish will be determined by **final bankroll** and prizes will be awarded as follows:

1st) TWO Dog Days of Summer Handicapping Contest entries valued at \$1,050. Entry includes all fees and NHC Tour membership.

2nd) TWO Dog Days of Summer Handicapping Contest entries valued at \$1,050. Entry includes all fees and NHC Tour membership.

3rd) TWO Dog Days of Summer Handicapping Contest entries valued at \$1,050. Entry includes all fees and NHC Tour membership.

4th) TWO Dog Days of Summer Handicapping Contest entries valued at \$550. Entry includes all fees and NHC Tour membership.

An additional Dog Days entry will be added at 50 entries, 56 entries, 61 entries, 66 entries and so forth.

If there are more than 44 entries and fewer than 50, cash prizes from those additional entry fees will be paid as follows:

1st) 50 percent 2nd) 30 percent 3rd) 15 percent 4th) 5 percent

To enter:

Entries will be taken on the day of the contest only. Each entrant must submit a \$140 non-refundable entry fee for each entry. At the time of entry, each player will be assigned an account-wagering card that will be used to place the 10 wagers.

Players with multiple entries can win multiple prizes however no player may accumulate more than three Dog Days entries. If a single player wins more than three Dog Days entries, they will receive the bankroll portion of that Dog Days entry.

There is no limit to the total number of entries to the contest.

Registrations and deadlines:

No entries accepted after 2:00 p.m. on March 25.

All players must enter in person on third floor on March 25. Participants cannot make tournament wagers until registration is complete and account card is assigned.

Contest rules:

Play begins on Saturday, March 25. The contest ends at approximately 5:30 p.m. (based on projected post times). A list of available tournament races will be provided in advance.

Players will make a total of 10 \$2 win/place wagers using the \$40 bankroll during the contest. A list of eligible tracks and races will be made available in advance. There are no price caps. Remaining bankrolls will be returned at contest conclusion.

Each \$2 Win/Place wager must be made on the same betting interest. Wagers cannot be split between horses in the same race.

Players must place all wagers personally. No person shall directly or indirectly act as an intermediary, transmitter or agent in placing wagers for the Player, unless authorized by Canterbury Park and for good reason shown.

Official payouts determined through the tote system will be used

If a scratch occurs involving a contest wager, the entrant may make a replacement wager. A scratch will not count toward final score.

A player may not make more than one contest wager on any given race. Players with multiple entries may wager on the same horse or same race using separate entries.

Any entrant found to have wagered on more than 10 races, more than \$2 Win/Place, or more than one horse per race will be disqualified from the tournament. Canterbury Park contest officials will then verify that no additional wagers have been made before declaring the winner.

No player may wager more than the allowed \$2 Win/Place and may not wager on more than 10 races. It is suggested that players make their wagers early to avoid being shut out of a race. It is the player's responsibility to make wagers in a timely fashion.

Contest scores will be posted throughout the contest beginning at approximately 2:00 pm.

The contest winners will be determined by winnings not number of winners. A tie for prize placings will result in a playoff as needed. All playing and betting disputes will be resolved by Canterbury Park officials.

Canceling an incorrect or mistaken wager is not always possible due to tote system constraints. Canterbury staff will make every attempt to assist in the event that an incorrect wager is placed, however it may not always be possible to cancel a wager prior to a race.

Requirements of Players:

Players must be 21 or older to enter.

Liability for any taxes incurred through prize winnings are the sole responsibility of player.

Ineligibility:

The following people are ineligible to play: AmTote employees. Any person forbidden to play the horses at Canterbury Park.

Cancellation of tournament:

Canterbury Park management reserves the right to cancel the contest for any reason at any time.

Canterbury Park assumes no liability for any unforeseen occurrence during the contest.

Canterbury Park reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions regarding the contest, without claim for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions regarding the contest, which are not specifically listed under these rules will be decided by Canterbury Management. Those decisions will be final.

Canterbury Handicapper of the Year Points: winner: 3 points; 2nd: 2 points; 3rd: 1 point
