**15,000 Chips per Player**  
**20 Minute Levels**  
**No Limit Hold'em—Big Blind Ante**

Event plays in the Poker Room.  
This is a 1-day event and plays until completion.

Team registration opens at 3 PM at the Cashier Cage.  
Both players must register together at the Cashier Cage with their MVP Rewards card. Late entry and unlimited re-entry available through the break after level 8 (Approx. 8 PM). All pre-registered team's chip stacks will be in play at the start.

10 minute breaks after levels 4, 8, 10, 14, and 18.  
\$300 Team Buy-in/\$150 re-entry per player: \$120 Prize Pool, \$20 Entry Fee, \$10 Staff Appreciation. No refunds or exchanges.  
Payouts are based on total number of entries, plus re-entries, and follow our standard tournament payouts.

Rules of Tag-Team Play:

- 1) Teams are 2-players. After registration both players check in with the TD for their team wristband and seating assignment.
- 2) Both player's chips are put in play at the start of event at separate tables.
- 3) Teams initially play as individuals, at separate tables, through the registration period (end of level 8).
- 4) If a teammate goes bust during the registration period they have the option to re-enter for \$150 and 15,000 chips.
- 5) At the end of level 8, team's chips are combined into one stack. Players will tag out and alternate play at every level change.  
\*If your teammate goes bust before the start of level 9 and does not re-enter your team will play on the single remaining chip stack and continue to tag out at each level change.
- 6) Players must wear their team wristband at all times during play.
- 7) Players may only play on one team and may not change teams at any time.
- 8) One player per hand rule enforced at all times.

Rules of Big Blind Ante:

- 1) A single Ante is posted by the player in the Big Blind position only.
- 2) The Ante is posted first.
- 3) The Ante is dead money. All players may win the entire ante.
- 4) The Ante is same amount as the big blind and will never reduce.
