

Spring Tune-Up Satellite Handicapping Contest
Saturday, March 22, 2025

The tournament:

The Canterbury Park Spring Tune-Up Satellite Handicapping Contest is a one-day handicapping contest held at Canterbury Park, Shakopee, Minn. Saturday, March 22, 2025. Winners will be awarded Dog Days of Summer Contest entries and/or June 21 XpressBet online BCBC qualifier contest entries.

Total cost per entry is \$100.

Format:

Players will select one horse in each of **TEN pre-selected races** and will earn points based on a mythical \$20 across the board wager. Entries, with all selections, must be submitted prior to the first contest race. No changes are permitted after the contest begins.

Points are capped as follows: 600 win; 400 place; 200 show. All selections must be submitted prior to post time of the first contest race. Entrants will receive the post time favorite should a scratch occur. The 10 contest races selected from various tracks will be announced by March 20.

A maximum of EIGHT entries per person is allowed.

Order of contest finish will be determined by **final scores** and prizes will be awarded as follows:

1st) ONE Dog Days of Summer Handicapping Contest entry valued at \$550. (Entry includes all fees and NHC Tour membership) and ONE June 21 XpressBet online contest entry valued at \$500.

2nd) ONE Dog Days of Summer Handicapping Contest entry valued at \$550. (Entry includes all fees and NHC Tour membership) and ONE June 21 XpressBet online contest entry valued at \$500.

3rd) ONE Dog Days of Summer Handicapping Contest entry valued at \$550. (Entry includes all fees and NHC Tour membership) and ONE June 21 XpressBet online contest entry valued at \$500.

4th) ONE Dog Days of Summer Handicapping Contest entry valued at \$550. (Entry includes all fees and NHC Tour membership) and ONE June 21 XpressBet online contest entry valued at \$500.

An additional June 21 entry will be added at 47 entries, 52 entries, 57 entries, 62 entries and so forth and will be awarded by score. For example with 52 entries the fifth and sixth scores will receive one entry.

If there are more than 43 entries and fewer than 47, cash from those additional entry fees will be paid to fifth place finisher.

To enter:

Entries may be submitted on March 22 beginning at 10:00 a.m.
No player may have more than eight entries.

Registrations and deadlines:

No entries accepted after contest begins which is estimated to be **1 p.m.**

Should there be a tie, the winner will be player selecting the most first-place horses. If a tie still exists, the winner will be the player selecting the most second-place horses. If a tie still exists then the winner will be the player selecting the most third-place horses. A coin toss would determine the winner if a tie still exists.

Requirements of Players:

Entrants must be 18 or older. Some prizes in Dog Days final require winners to be 21.

Ineligibility:

The following people are ineligible to play: Any person forbidden to play the horses at Canterbury Park.

Cancellation of tournament:

Canterbury Park management reserves the right to cancel the contest for any reason at any time.

Canterbury Park assumes no liability for any unforeseen occurrence during the contest.

Canterbury Park reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions regarding the contest, without claim for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions regarding the contest, which are not specifically listed under these rules will be decided by Canterbury Management. Those decisions will be final.

Canterbury Handicapper of the Year Points: winner: 3 points; 2nd: 2 points; 3rd: 1 point
