**30,000 Chips**

**Levels 1-19: 30 Minutes**

**Levels 20+: 40 Minutes**

**No Limit Hold'em—Big Blind Ante**

Event plays in the Poker Room.

Registration opens 2 hours prior to the start on the day of play.

Players register at the Casino Cashier Cage with their MVP Rewards card.

All pre-registered player's chip stacks will be in play at the start.

Late registration and unlimited re-entry available through the break after level 12 (approx. 5:30/9:30 PM). Players may re-enter the same flight if they bust out during the registration period. All late entries/re-entries will receive a full chip stack and must be checked in to their table by the start of level 13.

Day-1 flights play down to 11% of entries (rounded up). Day-2 will start at the earliest end time of all day-1 flights. Players bagging chips and advancing to day-2 are "in the money." Advancing player's chips will be bagged and tagged for Day-2 redraw. Day-2 seating is random draw and will be posted after the completion of the final day-1 flight. Players must show valid ID on Day-2 to claim their bag.

Best Stack Forward: Players may opt to play multiple flights and advance their largest chip stack to day-2. If a player bags more than once their smaller chip stack will be removed from play and receive the minimum posted payout.

Redraws on day-2 will occur at 27 players and final table of 9.

Day-1 Breaks: 10 minute break after levels, 4, 8, 12, and 14.

Day-2 breaks: 10 minute break approx. every 3 levels. 40 minute break once the final table of 9 is reached.

\$800 Buy-in: \$695 Prize Pool, \$80 Entry Fee, \$25 Staff Appreciation.

No refunds or exchanges.

**Rules of Big Blind Ante:**

- 1) The Big Blind is posted first.
- 2) A single Ante is posted by the player in the Big Blind position only.
- 3) The Ante is the same amount as the Big Blind.
- 4) The Ante is dead money. All other players may win the ante.
