

**Canterbury Park Satellite Handicapping Contest**  
**Saturday, August 16, 2025**

**The tournament:**

The Canterbury Park Satellite Handicapping Contest is a one-day handicapping contest held at Canterbury Park, Shakopee, Minn. Saturday, August 16, 2025. The Aug. 16 Satellite will qualify players to the Aug. 23-24 Dog Days Tournament and the Sept. 20 XpressBet NHC Qualifier.

Total cost per entry is \$100.

One player for the first 11 entries will win ONE Dog Days entry and ONE XpressBet NHC Qualifier entry and an NHC Tour ID if needed.

If there are 12 to 15 entries, the additional entry fees will awarded to the second-place finisher. If there are 16 entries the second -place finisher will have a choice of ONE Dog Days entry or ONE Sept. 20 entry. If 17-20 entries, the extra cash goes to third score. If 21 entries, two prize packages will be awarded to the top two scores. If 26 entries, the third score gets choice of ONE Dog Days entry or ONE Sept. 20 entry and so on\*.

In the event that there is a tie between two or more players for a contest entry prize other than cash, the player with the most winning horses will win. In the event that the tie breaker results in additional tie, the winner will be determined by drawing.

**Format:**

Players will select one horse in each of **TEN pre-selected races** and will earn points based on a mythical \$20 across the board wager. Entries, with all selections, must be submitted prior to the first contest race. No changes are permitted after the contest begins.

Points are capped as follows: 600 win; 400 place; 200 show. All selections must be submitted prior to post time of the first contest race. Entrants will receive the post time favorite should a scratch occur. Additional Winners will be determined by score.

The 10 contest races selected from various tracks will be announced by Aug 14.

**To enter:**

Entries may be submitted on Aug. 16 beginning at 10:00 a.m.

No player may have more than eight entries.

**Registrations and deadlines:**

No entries accepted after contest begins which is estimated to be noon.

Should there be a tie for a prize that cannot be divided, the winner will be player selecting the most first-place horses. If a tie still exists, the winner will be the player selecting the most second-place horses. If a tie still exists then the winner will be the player selecting the most third-place horses. A coin toss would determine the winner if a tie still exists.

**Requirements of Players:**

Entrants must be 18 or older. Prizes in Dog Days and Sept. 20 final require winners to be 21.

**Ineligibility:**

The following people are ineligible to play: Any person forbidden to play the horses at Canterbury Park.

**Cancellation of tournament:**

Canterbury Park management reserves the right to cancel the contest for any reason at any time.

Canterbury Park assumes no liability for any unforeseen occurrence during the contest.

Canterbury Park reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions regarding the contest, without claim for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions regarding the contest, which are not specifically listed under these rules will be decided by Canterbury Management. Those decisions will be final.

**Canterbury Handicapper of the Year Points:** winner: 3 points; 2<sup>nd</sup>: 2 points; 3<sup>rd</sup>: 1 point

\*Players winning Dog Days or Sept. 20 contest entries that already have maximum number of entries for those events will receive \$400 for entries over the maximum.
