*Benchmark feature: If a player accumulates 75,000 chips (or more) they are responsible for alerting the TD to verify their chip count. Once the chips are verified the TD will remove the player's entire chip stack and award the player their payout. If a player continues to play and their chip count falls below 75,000 they no longer qualify.
