Breaks may be adjusted at Tournament Director discretion.

\$300 Buy-in: \$250 Prize Pool, \$35 Entry Fee, \$15 Staff Appreciation. No refunds or exchanges.

Payout: Top 10% 1 in 10 entries) win \$2,400 Lammers + \$100 cash. Any remaining prize pool less than \$2,500 will be paid to the player on the bubble in lammers.
