

**Bet On Yourself in R2K
Handicapping Contest 2026**

Summary : Bet On Yourself in R2K is a series of single-day contests at Canterbury Park beginning Saturday, Jan. 17, 2026 where players submit a \$10 entry fee and compete for a prize pool consisting of all entry fees collected on the day of each contest with the winner being determined by the highest score recorded by an entrant in that day's Road to Kentucky Handicapping Contest .

Of the players entered each date, the entire pool of entry fees collected that day will be paid as the prize pool to the entrant with the highest score.

To be eligible to win, players must have entered the Road to Kentucky Contest using a valid entry form and must submit a \$10 entry fee for Bet On Yourself by contest deadline.

Duration: The contest will run each Saturday from January 17 through May 2, 2026.

Entry: Official entry forms will be available at the third level Information Center each contest day.

Entrants must complete the entry form and submit it along with the \$10 fee prior to the entry deadline. Entrants must be enrolled in the MVP Rewards program. Membership in the MVP Rewards program is free. Entry deadline is the start of each day's Road to Kentucky Contest. Entry fee in this contest is not applied to wagering minimums required for Road to Kentucky.

Results: Official results are based on the official results of Road to Kentucky Contest.

Ties: In the event of a tie, prize money will be divided equally.

Cancellation: Bet On Yourself daily contest will be cancelled if Road to Kentucky is cancelled.

Posting Of Results: Results will be posted at the 3rd level Information Center and at www.canterburypark.com once Road to Kentucky scores are final weekly.

Eligibility / Ineligibility: The following are ineligible to participate in this tournament: anyone under the age of 18; anyone forbidden to play the horses at Canterbury Park.

Judging and Disputes: The management of Canterbury Park reserves the right to interpret all questions and conditions in regard to this event, without claim for damages or recourse of any kind. All questions and definitions not covered explicitly in these rules will be decided by the management of Canterbury Park, with those decisions to be final.

Affidavits: Affidavits confirming compliance with contest rules will be required of all winners. Any winner found to be in violation of contest rules will be considered ineligible.

Handicapper of the Year Points: The winning entrant will receive one Handicapper of the Year point. For more information on Canterbury's Handicapper of the Year contest visit the Information Center.

Prize Money: Winnings will be distributed after noon the Friday following each contest when Road to Kentucky scores become official.
