30,000 Chips 30 Minute Levels No Limit Hold'em—Big Blind Ante

Multi-day event. Event plays on Track Level.

Registration opens 2 hours prior to the start on the day of play.

Players must register at the Casino Cashier Cage with their MVP Rewards card and valid ID. All pre-registered player's chip stacks will be in play at the start.

Late registration and unlimited re-entry available through the break after level 10 (approx. 4 PM/10:30 PM). Players may re-enter the same flight if they bust out during the registration period. All late entries/re-entries will receive a full chip stack and must be checked in to their table by the start of level 11.

Each Day-1 flight plays down to 11% of entries (rounded up).

Players may only bag once. If a player bags chips in day-1A they <u>MAY NOT</u> play 1B or 1C. Day-2 will start at the earliest end time.

Advancing player's chips will be bagged and tagged for Day-2 redraw.

Day-2 seating is random draw and will be posted after the completion of Day-1C. All players advancing to Day-2 are "in the money."

Mystery Bounties will be active at the start of day-2. See more information on Mystery Bounties on page-2.

Event plays 9-handed.

Redraws on day-2 will occur at 27 players and final table of 9.

Day-1 breaks: 10 minute break after levels 4, 8, 10, and 14.

Day-2 breaks: 10 minute break approx. every 4 levels. 30 minute extended break

once the final table of 9 is reached.

\$400 Buy-in: \$100 Mystery Bounty Pool, \$230 Prize Pool, \$50 Entry Fee, \$20 Staff

Appreciation. No refunds or exchanges.

Rules of Big Blind Ante:

- 1) The Big Blind is posted first.
- 2) A single Ante is posted by the player in the Big Blind position only.
- 3) The Ante is the same amount as the Big Blind.
- 4) The Ante is dead money. All other players may win the ante.

Event plays on Track Level.

Each Day-1 flight plays down to 11% of entries (rounded up).

Players may only bag once. If a player bags chips in day-1A they MAY NOT play 1B or 1C.

Day-2 will start at the earliest end time.

Advancing player's chips will be bagged and tagged for Day-2 redraw.

Mystery Bounty prizes will range in value from \$50 to \$10,000.

Day-2 seating is random draw and will be posted after the completion of the last day-1 flight.

All players advancing to Day-2 are "in the money." Players must have valid ID to claim their bag on day-2. Day-2 will start at the earliest end time of each day-1 flight.

Mystery Bounties become active at the start of day-2. Every player advancing to day-2 will be a Mystery Bounty. Mystery Bounty prizes will be posted after the completion of 1C and prior to the start of day-2.

Bounties may include the following amounts:

\$10,000 \$4,500	\$1,000 \$500	\$150 \$100

On day-2 players eliminating another player will be issued a Mystery Bounty Claim Ticket. Claim Tickets are non-transferable. Player must redeem the claim ticket at the Mystery Bounty redemption table on the day of the event, and a prize will be randomly drawn.

If a player is eliminated by multiple players the mystery bounty will be split evenly amongst all players who won the hand and covered the all-in bet. (The player closest clockwise from the button will draw the prize.)

Mystery Bounty prizes must be redeemed on the same day as the event. Any unclaimed bounty prizes will be randomly drawn at the end of the event.
