*Benchmark: If a player accumulates 75,000 chips (or more) they are responsible for alerting the TD to verify their chip count. Once the chip count is verified the TD will remove the player's entire chip stack and award the player their payout. If a player continues to play, and their chip count falls below 75,000, they no longer qualify for a payout.

Rules of Big Blind Ante:

- 1) The Big Blind is posted first.
- 2) A single Ante is posted by the player in the Big Blind position only.
- 3) The Ante is the same amount as the Big Blind.
- 4) The Ante is dead money. All other players may win the ante.

Special events do not qualify for Tournament Jackpot.
