INCIDENTS/INQUIRIES/OBJECTIONS:

Stewards Inquiry, 2nd Race: The Stewards posted the inquiry sign following the 2ND race to evaluate observed interference at the 1/8 pole. Jockey Eduardo Gallardo also claimed foul. The films show #2 "KALATUA", ridden by Jockey Manuel Americano, allowed his mount to drift in and bump #4 "SHANCES R" with Jockey Gallardo very hard, turning that one sideways knocking him off stride. # 2 brushed with a #1 in a chain reaction. For that action, #2 was disqualified from first and placed third behind #4. Jockey Americano will review the race with the Stewards on Thursday.
