No HISA Fees for Canterbury Park Horsepeople

In partnership with the Minnesota Racing Commission, Canterbury Park is proud to announce once again there will be no HISA per start fees passed on to our horsepeople in 2026. The MRC and Canterbury Park are continuing to work together to cover this cost.

The Horseracing Integrity & Safety Authority

All persons participating in thoroughbred racing at Canterbury Park are required to register as a Covered Person with The Horseracing Integrity & Safety Authority (HISA). All thoroughbred race horses are required to be registered with HISA as Covered Horses on the date of their first timed and reported workout.

The Racetrack Safety Rules and Anti-Doping and Medication Control (ADMC) program are implemented at Canterbury Park.

Any current and pending HISA rule changes that may go into effect before or during the 2026 Live Racing Season will be enforced at Canterbury Park.

2026 Live Race Meet Notifications

Please read the Condition Book thoroughly for all information pertaining to the 2026 Canterbury Park Live Racing Season. For up-to-date rules including but not limited to HISA regulations, permitted medication thresholds, NSAID rules and workout requirements, please be sure to check with the Minnesota Racing Commission Veterinarian's Office, Stewards' Office and/or on the Minnesota Racing Commission's website at www.mrc.state.mn.us or the HISA website as hisaus.org.

Maximum Field Sizes

Please note, in all overnight and stakes races, also-eligible and main track only entries will be taken up to a maximum of 16 total entrants. The following chart indicates the maximum number of starters at each particular distance on each course in both stakes and overnight races. Management reserves the right to alter these sizes at any time throughout the season.

Shavings Required for Bedding in 2026

Due to issues with disposal, straw bedding will not be allowed on the grounds in 2026. All stalls must be bedded with wood shavings or another approved biodegradable material. Because of the packaging, bagged shavings are preferred; however bulk shavings will be allowed as long as they are cleaned up and stored daily. Any loose or unruly piles of shavings, left outside overnight, will be removed at the owner's expense and future deliveries restricted.

The Racing Office will be closed on Mondays, Tuesdays and Fridays except the days which we enter. The Racing Office will open at 8:00 a.m. on entry days and entries will close at 10:30 a.m.

Scratch Policy

All scratches at Canterbury Park may only be done by permission of the Stewards and according to MRC Rule.

Eligibility

Horses 6 years of age or older and are a first time starter or maiden are not eligible to race at Canterbury Park, nor are horses that have not started in 2 or more years. Horses 12 years of age and older are not eligible to race at Canterbury Park.

No horse shall be permitted to start if it has raced more than 3 times in 30 consecutive days.

Pregnant mares are ineligible to race in claiming races and those over 120 days gestation are ineligible to compete in all races.

Turf Shoe Policies

For thoroughbreds, the HISA horseshoe rule is in effect for training and racing. On the turf, traction devices are prohibited on forelimb and hindlimb horseshoes. For more information regarding traction devices, visit hisaus.org.

If management considers it inadvisable for any reason to not run a scheduled turf race on the turf course, it will be run on the main track at the following distances:

***** Two-year-old turf races carded at 7 & 1/2 furlongs will be run at 6 furlongs on the main track if management considers it inadvisable to run on the turf.***

Preference Date System

1. Preference dates will not supersede conditions of a race. See following page, sections entitled "Condition Eligibility Preference" & "Winners Preferred" for additional information.
2. All thoroughbreds registered prior to 4:00 p.m. **Friday, May 15, 2026** and all quarter horses registered prior to 4:00 p.m. **Wednesday, June 10, 2026** will receive a zero which is the lowest possible date. A horse keeps a zero until he/she runs or scratches or the digital certificate or foal papers are removed from the Racing Office.
3. All thoroughbreds registering after Friday, May 15 and all quarter horses registering after Wednesday, June 10 will receive an "E" date corresponding to the racing day of the meeting when registered.
4. Horses without a digital certificate or foal papers on file in the Racing Office will be least preferred. A current coggins must be attached to the foal papers or a digital copy must be submitted to the Racing Office in order to receive a preference date.
5. Preference dates are good for any type of race or distance with the exception of stakes and trials. **Horses starting in stakes races and trials will retain their previous date.**
6. Horses that run will receive an "R" date corresponding to the date they race and lose all dates previously held. Should a horse be registered or come off a list on a non-racing day, the next racing day will be used as the preference date.
7. When a turf race is removed from the turf, all horses that run on the main track retain their previously held preference date.
8. Horses that are scratched will receive an "S" date corresponding to the race date they scratch.
9. A zero has first preference and an "E" date takes preference over an "R" date of the same day. An "R" date takes preference over an "S" date of the same day.
10. Horses that establish an "E" date will keep their date until drawing into the body of the race, at which point they will receive an "R" date. Horses which make the body of a race at another racetrack after receiving an "E" date will forfeit any date they have established at Canterbury Park.
11. All thoroughbreds will receive a dirt preference date and a turf preference date. Racing or scratching on one surface will not affect a horse's date for the other surface.

Preference Date System Continued

12. In an effort to ensure that racing fans have an opportunity to wager on a reasonable number of horses, the following policies are in place concerning turf entries:

Entries will be accepted in turf races for Main Track Only horses (main track only entries). Trainers must declare MTO at time of entry. An MTO entry has no preference to draw into a turf race as a starter and will be carded as an also-eligible at all times even if the race doesn't overfill. A maximum of two MTO entries will be drawn as also eligibles in overfilled turf races. MTO entries will draw a post position in both stakes and overnight races, unless least preferred.

In overfilled turf races, MTO also-eligibles will have first preference to draw into the race in order of their date preference. In-Today horses re-entering as MTO entries shall only be allowed to do so if originally entered as an MTO or also-eligible. If the race remains on the turf, MTO entries, regardless of whether the race is overfilled or not, will not be eligible to start. When a race is removed from the turf, MTO horses will receive a date if they run or scratch. If the race remains on the turf, MTO horses will retain their previous date.

Scratch time for turf is 8:30 a.m. the day of the race for day cards and 12:00 p.m. the day of the race for night cards.

13. *All horses placed on the Stewards', Starter's or Veterinarian's list will be posted in the office. They will not be permitted to enter until they have been approved to start. Vets' list horses awaiting a negative blood test may be permitted to enter pending the results but are not permitted to start unless negative results are received by scratch time on race day. A horse **which ran** before going on a list will keep its running date. Horses which were **scratched** will be given a running date of the day the horse comes off the list.

14. Horses which have established a date at the current meeting will lose their preference should their digital certificate or foal papers be withdrawn from the Racing Office or demonstrate intent to race elsewhere and must reestablish a preference date at this meeting.

15. In no way does the claiming, tattooing, corrections, ownership transfer or trainer transfer of a horse affect the preference date.

16. When a horse's name appears in a race, other than a stakes or trial, and is entered for a following day, the entry will be given no consideration should the race in which it is entered overfill.

17. Preference lists will be posted daily and are official unless a claim of error is made by a horseperson.

18. It is the responsibility of a person making an entry to claim preference at time of entry. The stewards will consider no claims that do not comply with the above regulations.

**Please note this is a pending MRC rule change that may alter this section of the rulebook prior to the start of the 2026 season.*

Condition Eligibility Preference

Condition eligibility preference will apply to all races at Canterbury Park. In open, money and dated allowance races, horses with the most allowance wins shall be preferred. In Allowance/Optional Claiming races, horses eligible for and running for the allowance condition shall be given first preference. Horses running for a claiming price in such races will be given second preference through the Canterbury Park preference date system.

Winners Preferred

In all races written for winners, including stakes races, winners shall be preferred. In all lifetime condition races, horses best fitting the condition shall be preferred (i.e. a non-winner of two entering a non-winner of three will be given second preference behind all non-winners of three).

Stakes with Allowance Conditions

Unless stated otherwise in race conditions, for all allowance stakes:

1. High weights are always preferred, followed by Graded Stakes winners 12 months prior to race date, followed by Graded Stakes placed horses 12 months prior to race date, followed by Stakes winners within 12 months, Stakes placed within 12 months, highest earnings in non-claiming/starter races in the past 12 months prior to race date.
2. All thoroughbred Stakes races will be run without Lasix. Trainers must declare OFF LASIX at time of entry.

Entry Rules

Horses penalized in a race shall not be entitled to any of the allowances in such a race. Horses not entitled to first allowance in a race are not entitled to the second, and if not to the second, then to no subsequent allowances.

Owners and trainers must be careful to claim allowances at the time of entry as well as state penalties and are solely responsible if a horse starts with the wrong weight thereby causing a disqualification.

Owners and trainers must be careful to opt to declare a horse ineligible to be claimed (Waiver Claiming Rule) based on MRC 7883.0140 at the time of entry as this may not be remedied following the close of entries. To meet these conditions, the horse must: 1) have been laid off for a period of 120 days or more; 2) have last been an official starter in a claiming race from which it was eligible to be claimed; and 3) must be entered for a claiming price equal to or greater than at which it last started.

Management, through contractual agreement with the Minnesota HBPA, reserves the right to call off any overnight race with less than eight interests.

Canterbury Park reserves the right to cancel any stakes or other race prior to the actual running thereof - without liability - except for the return of nomination and entry fees paid.

All ownerships of a horse shall be filed with the Racing Secretary before the horse shall start.

No more than three horses of the same interest shall be entered in any overnight event. The second or third trainer entry with a different owner has the same preference as a single owner entry.

In stakes races, highweights will be preferred, winners preferred. A sex allowance for female horses in races with male horses will not count against a female horse for the purposes of highweights. Horses not drawing a starting position in the gate will receive a refund of the entry fee but will not be refunded any nomination or sustaining payments made to keep the horse eligible for the race.

Uncoupled Entries

All horses owned wholly or in part by the same person, or his or her spouse, shall be coupled and run as an entry. However, the association may uncouple entries in any race with the permission of the stewards.

Naming of Jockeys

Any authorized person entering a horse in any given race shall at the time of making such an entry name the jockey for said horse.

Trainers must have an apprentice jockey engaged before claiming the apprentice allowance.

Apprentice allowances waived at the draw cannot be reclaimed.

Should a jockey remain unnamed at the time of the drawing of entries, the Stewards or their appointees shall select one. No jockey, once named, shall be changed except for good cause by the Stewards.

Jockeys having engagements to ride must be in the scale room one hour before post time. After making weights, jockeys must not leave the jockey room until all engagements for the day have been filled.

Jockeys are forbidden in the betting enclosure from one hour prior to post time for the first race. Those who violate this rule may be fined or suspended.

Any jockey taken off mounts due to illness or injury is not eligible to be named on horses until cleared by the Track Paramedic, who will notify the Stewards.

A jockey engaged to ride any horse is bound to fulfill his/her engagement unless excused by the Stewards. Should a rider become injured or ill on the way to the post or at the gate and the Stewards designate a substitute rider, such rider will fulfill the order of the Stewards and complete the engagement on the horse.

Transfer of Horse on the Grounds

The purchase, claim or transfer of any horse on the grounds at Canterbury Park - whether by private sale, claiming, or public auction - does not guarantee the new owner a stall for said horse. Canterbury Park management reserves the right to allocate stalls.

Horses will be permitted to start only upon producing a physical or digital certificate of registration from the Jockey Club showing colors and markings to correspond and having the necessary lip or digital tattoo.

All horses coming to the track must have listed on their Jockey Club registration certificate all transfers of ownerships. No horse will be permitted to start without such accurate and complete record. This rule is for your protection. Be sure your physical or digital certificates are up-to-date.

Minnesota Bred Conditions and Claiming Prices

In allowance races that are written for N2X MCS or N3X MCS or state bred, state bred wins will not count for eligibility. Additionally, in open company races, Minnesota bred horses will enter for a higher claiming price. For example:

Races restricted to Minnesota bred horses will be contested for the higher claiming price. For example, in an open company \$5,000 N2L, Minnesota bred horses will carry a \$7,500 claiming price. When restricted to Minnesota bred horses, all entrants will run for \$7,500.

Workout Rules

1. A thoroughbred horse which has not started for a period of 46 days or more shall not be eligible to start until it has completed one timed workout within 45 days and **no less than 48 hours** prior to the race in which it is entered.
2. A thoroughbred horse which has not started for a period of 61 days or more shall not be eligible to start until it has completed two timed workouts within 60 days and **no less than 48 hours** prior to the race in which it is entered.
3. A quarter horse which has not started for a period of 46 days or more shall not be eligible to start until it has completed one timed workout within 45 days and **no less than 48 hours** prior to the race in which it is entered. A quarter horse which has not started in 61 days or more shall not be eligible to start until it has completed two timed workouts within 60 days and **no less than 48 hours** prior to the race in which it is entered.
4. A first-time starter four years of age or older must have gate approval and a minimum of three timed workouts, at least one of which must be out of the gate within 60 days and one of which must be an official timed workout observed and approved by a Commission Veterinarian no more than 45 days prior to the race for which the horse is entered. Thoroughbreds must work no less than five furlongs and quarter horses no less than 220 yards.
5. A horse, other than a first-time starter, which has not started for a period of more than one year shall not be eligible to start until it has completed three timed workouts, at least one of which must be an official timed workout before a Commission Veterinarian. Thoroughbreds must work no less than five furlongs and quarter horses no less than 220 yards.
6. A horse that has not started for a period of 6 months to one year must be examined by a Commission Veterinarian prior to starting. Pending the results of the examination, a workout may be required at the determination of the Commission Veterinarian. Thoroughbreds must work at least five furlongs and quarter horses no less than 220 yards.
7. First-time starters less than four years of age must have gate approval and a minimum of two timed workouts, one of which must be out of the gate, no more than 60 days and **no less than 48 hours** prior to the race in which it is entered.
8. *All official timed workouts as defined by Minnesota Racing Commission Rules shall be conducted under the same medication and testing requirements as those required for race days. A horse that needs an official timed work must be examined by a practicing veterinarian within 48 to 96 hours prior to the official timed workout. Written documentation of a successful examination must be submitted prior to the official timed workout. A horse is not eligible to be started until negative results of post-workout medication testing have been returned to the Commission Veterinarian. Check with the Commission Veterinarian or refer to the Trainer's Manual for additional requirements.
9. All quarter horses racing 870 yards for the first time must have a recorded workout of at least 660 yards before they will be approved to run.

**Please note this is a pending MRC rule change that may alter this section of the rulebook prior to the start of the 2026 season.*

Canterbury Park Humane Treatment Policy

Canterbury Park requires its racing participants to adhere to its humane treatment policy. The policy states:

Any owner or trainer stabled at Canterbury Park who knowingly, or without conducting proper due diligence, sells a horse for slaughter, directly or indirectly, or who is associated with the shipment of horses via cargo container or cargo ship will have his or her stalls permanently revoked by Canterbury Park. Canterbury Park requires its owners and trainers to conduct due diligence on those individuals buying horses and in the transportation used by those individuals. Canterbury Park encourages its owners and trainers to support accredited retirement and adoption efforts and to find humane ways of dealing with horses unable to continue racing.

Canterbury Park Stakes Race Information

The Rules and Regulations of racing adopted by the Minnesota Racing Commission govern all races run over the Canterbury Park course. Nominations to stakes are received only with the understanding that the officers of this Association reserve the right to refuse the nomination at a later date and/or to refuse the transfer of the nomination to another party.

All disputes, claims and objections arising out of the racing or with respect to the interpretation of the conditions of any stakes shall be decided by the Stewards and their decision upon all points shall be final.

Canterbury Park reserves the right to cancel any stakes or other race prior to the actual running thereof - without liability - except for the return of nomination and entry fees paid.

If management considers it inadvisable for any reason to run a scheduled turf race on the turf course, it will be run at the appropriate distance on the main track as outlined in this Condition Book under the subsection entitled Turf Policies.

Winner or non-winner of a stated sum means winner or non-winner of a single race of that value to the first place horse.

Canterbury Park reserves the right to reject any nominations or to reduce the amount of added money.

All thoroughbred Stakes races will be run without Lasix. Trainers must declare OFF LASIX at time of entry.

It is required that all horses be vaccinated against rhinopneumonitis (EHV1 and EHV4) and influenza no less than 14 days and no more than 180 days before entering the grounds. Under HISA rules, Thoroughbreds must be vaccinated for Eastern Encephalitis virus/Western Encephalitis virus, West Nile virus and Tetanus (EEE/WEE/WNV/Tetanus) and Rabies at least 12 months prior to arrival. Additionally, Canterbury Park reserves the right to mandate any additional vaccine(s) as a condition of admittance based on pandemic or outbreak. For more information on shipping in, please reference Notice for Horsepersons Racing/Shipping from Off Grounds and the Stall Application.

Quarter Horse Stakes Race Information

Checks that are stamped non-sufficient funds will automatically cancel eligibility to the specific Stake race. Horses dropped from the race for non-sufficient funds will not be eligible for late payments or supplemental nominations. Checks returned for any other reason may also cancel eligibility, at the discretion of management.

Notice for Horsepersons Approved for Stalls

Each horse coming through the stable gate, including stable ponies, must have submitted:

1. A legible Certificate of Veterinary Inspection (CVI) signed by a veterinarian that is dated within 5 days of entry and includes for each individual horse: the horse's name and ID, rectal temperature, EIA or Coggins information (date, lab and accession number), rhinopneumonitis (EHV-1 and EHV-4) and influenza vaccination information (date vaccinated, product name and the expiration date of the product). Thoroughbreds must have all additional HISA required vaccination information, including the vaccination date on their CVI. This should be submitted by email at least 48 in advance of arrival to: mrcinfo@state.mn.us.
2. A Coggins (EIA) test dated within the 12 months prior to the date the horse first enters the grounds. The results for each horse must be clearly marked on the CVI and must be legible and accurate. A copy of the Coggins must be submitted to the Racing Office prior to entering the horse. No horse may start in a race unless a negative Coggins test has been reported within the prior 12 months.
3. Vaccination for rhinopneumonitis (EHV-1 and EHV-4) and influenza by a veterinarian must be no less than 14 days and no more than 180 days prior to arrival. Other vaccinations required for thoroughbreds by HISA include EEE/WEE/WNV/Tetanus and rabies no more than 12 months prior to arrival.
4. Quarter Horses with a CVI originating from a state with suspect cases of Equine Piroplasmosis (EP) must have a negative test for *Theileria equi* taken within the 12 months prior to September 19, 2026. Currently this includes Texas but trainers and owners are encouraged to check the Minnesota Racing Commission website (www.mn.gov/mrc) for additional states with a suspect status.
5. No horse will be allowed to enter the grounds, enter a race, or be permitted to start unless a current, valid CVI covering said horse is submitted. It is current if it is dated not more than 5 days prior to the date the horse described in the certificate arrives in Minnesota for the first time in a calendar year.
6. For the 2026 racing season, copies of the Coggins and CVI should be submitted electronically to the Commission Veterinarian's Office (mrcinfo@state.mn.us) at least 48 hours prior to the horse entering the grounds. Failure to do so may result in a significant delay at the stable gate.

Notice for Horsepersons Racing/Shipping from Off-Grounds

1. All horses stabled off-grounds must arrive no later than 8:00 a.m. the day of the race at Canterbury Park. Horses coming from other states must provide the MRC Veterinarian's Office a copy of their previous 14 days of veterinary treatments.
2. Only MRC licensed personnel registered with HISA are allowed in the Detention Barn. Your employees must have their MRC license with their HISA Registration Number on it in their possession.
3. If your horse is to be treated with furosemide, you must sign the horse up in the MRC Veterinarian's Office prior to administration. It is the trainer's responsibility to obtain the services of a private DVM licensed by the MRC to administer furosemide. A schedule of administration times may be obtained from the Veterinarian's Office or HBP Office.
4. Horses shipping in and out from Minnesota will need to contact the Veterinarian's Office for additional information regarding their Health Certificates (CVI).

Minnesota Racing Commission Medication Rules

All horses participating in racing at Canterbury Park must be in compliance with the Minnesota Racing Commission (MRC) rules relating to medication. Information regarding medication rules is provided in the Trainer's Manual which can be obtained in the Stewards' Office or the MRC Veterinarian's Office.

Medication Testing

1. HISA, the Stewards or an MRC Veterinarian may require any horse on the grounds to submit to a blood, urine or other biological test. This includes out-of-competition testing, TCO2 testing, and hair testing. If selected, no horse is eligible to start in a race until the owner or trainer complies with any required testing procedure.
2. Blood and urine test samples will be taken from the winner of every race and at least one other horse.
3. All claimed horses are tested and must stay at the detention barn for one full hour after finishing the race.

Medication Thresholds

1. The MRC uses an amended version of ARCI therapeutic guidelines for Quarter Horses and the HIWU ADMC program for Thoroughbreds. Information regarding medication rules may be found on the MRC website, on the HISA website, and in the Trainer's Manual which can be obtained from the Stewards or the MRC Veterinarian's Office.
2. It is strongly suggested that the trainer and/or practicing veterinarian consult with the MRC Veterinarians on the use of any medication, including supplements not classified in the ARCI's or HIWU's guidelines.



Minnesota Racing Commission Medication Rules

Minnesota Administrative Rules Chapter 7890.0100 Subpart 13 defines Medication as a substance, compound, or element, or combination thereof, which is or can be administered to a horse for the purpose of preventing, curing, or alleviating the effects of any disease, condition, ailment, or infirmity, or symptom thereof, or for altering in any way the behavior, attitude, temperament, or performance of a horse, including athletic performance. Medication includes all alkalinizing agents, analgesics, anesthetics, depressants, narcotics, stimulants, tranquilizers and other classifications of medications.

Non-Steroidal Anti-Inflammatory Drugs (NSAIDs)

1. For Thoroughbred horses, all HIWU rules are followed.
2. For Quarter Horses, refer to the 2026 MRC Therapeutic Guidelines or the Trainer's manual available from the Stewards and MRC Veterinarians.

Furosemide

1. To be eligible for the furosemide program, trainers must sign up each horse into the program. This is done by the trainer or assistant trainer physically coming into the MRC Veterinarian's Office and filling out the appropriate paperwork.
2. Furosemide is not permissible in 2-year-old horses. Horses must be 3 years old or older to be eligible to receive furosemide. Furosemide is not permitted in Thoroughbred horses entered into a stakes race.
3. Furosemide in a dose not less than 150mg and not more than 250mg must be administered intravenously (IV) by a licensed veterinarian employed by the trainer or owner of the horse a minimum of four (4) hours prior to the scheduled post time.
4. An attendant must be present at the time of administration. Violation of this rule will result in the horse being scratched and the trainer being fined.

Bisphosphonates

1. The trainer or owner of any horse treated with a bisphosphonate drug must immediately notify the MRC Veterinarian when the horse enters the grounds.
2. Any horse treated with a bisphosphonate drug will be placed on the Veterinarian's List for a minimum of 6 months following the most recent administration.
3. No horse treated with a bisphosphonate drug within the past 6 months may be entered to race.
4. No person may possess a bisphosphonate drug on the grounds.

Thyroid Supplements

1. The use of a thyroid supplement is limited to a hypothyroid horse diagnosed with a thyrotropin releasing hormone (TRH) stimulation test.
2. Results of the TRH test must be submitted to the MRC Veterinarian and approved prior to the horse receiving a thyroid supplement.
3. If a horse is currently receiving a thyroid supplement, TRH test results must be provided to the MRC Veterinarian or thyroid supplement administration discontinued and TRH testing completed after a 30-day washout period.
4. If you have any thyroid supplements in your tack room or vehicle it is strongly recommended that you remove them from the grounds.

Clenbuterol and Albuterol

The use of clenbuterol and albuterol is prohibited in racing and training of Quarter Horses. Usage follows HIWU rules for Thoroughbreds.

Milkshaking (Alkalinizing Agents)

The administration of agents that alter a horse's total carbon dioxide concentration (TCO₂), including sodium bicarbonate (baking soda) and other alkalinizing agents, to a horse entered to compete at Canterbury Park within 48 hours of a race is prohibited. The MRC may perform physiological tests on any horse entered to race at Canterbury Park to determine total carbon dioxide concentrations (TCO₂). More information regarding alkalinizing agents can be found in the Trainer's Manual available from the MRC Veterinarian's Office or Stewards' Office.

***Official Timed Workouts**

All official timed workouts, including those required by HISA and HIWU, shall be conducted under the same medication and testing requirements as those required for race days. A horse may enter but is not eligible to start until negative results of post-workout medication testing have been returned to the MRC Veterinarian. A horse needing an official timed workout must be examined by a practicing veterinarian within 48 to 96 hours prior to the official timed workout and results of the examination provided to the MRC Veterinarian prior to scheduling the official timed workout. Check with the MRC Veterinarian or refer to the Trainer's Manual for additional requirements.

180 Day Inspection

Every horse that has not raced in 180 days or longer will have a physical examination conducted by one of the MRC Veterinarians. These stall examinations are done to identify any pre-existing or new conditions that may prevent a horse from having a catastrophic injury during training or racing. The MRC 180 Day Inspection is in addition to the HISA 150 Day Post Layoff Report, which is required by HISA.

Race Day Examinations

On each race day, trainers shall post a sign outside an entered horse's stall stating that the horse is "In Today". The sign must be posted by 8:00 am and be removed immediately upon the horse's return from racing. Signs can be obtained the Stall Superintendent in the Racing Office.

Every horse entered to race will have an examination on race day conducted by a MRC Veterinarian. All examinations include identification by physical tattoo or microchip, overall physical examination, auscultation of the heart as needed, manual palpation of the limbs, limb flexion as needed and jogging of the horse.

The MRC Veterinarian keeps a continuing health and racing soundness record of each horse examined and monitors for acute problems as well as changes in specific prior issues. Examination results are entered into the InCompass system, which are shared with regulatory veterinarians around the country.

Per MRC 7891.0100, every horse to be examined must have its legs cleaned of any poultice or other topical applications, be free of leg bandages or be wearing bandages which are easily removed and not have been subjected within one hour of examination to freezing, icing, prolonged hosing with cold water or any other means of reducing the temperature of the legs.

No horse shall be eligible to start in a race and shall be scratched by the Stewards if the trainer does not cooperate or the horse is found unfit to race, cannot be properly identified or improperly shod.

Drug Testing in Listed and Graded

All listed and graded races contested for thoroughbreds at Canterbury Park will be subject to the testing guidelines prescribed for such races by the Thoroughbred Owners and Breeders Association and the American Graded Stakes Committee in conjunction with HIWU.

**Please note this is a pending MRC rule change that may alter this section of the rulebook prior to the start of the 2026 season.*

Canterbury Park Safety Rules

In accordance with Minnesota Administrative Rules Chapter 7877.0170, Subp. 11:

- (A) Any person mounted on or driving a horse on association grounds, and any person handling a horse at the starting gate, must wear a properly secured safety helmet at all times.
- (B) Any person mounted on a horse, and any person handling a horse in the starting gate, must wear a properly secured safety vest at all times.

Safety Helmet Guidelines

Per MN §7877.0170, Subp. 11 (A);

The helmet must comply with one of the following minimum safety standards or later revisions: American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM 1163); European Standards (EN-1384 or PAS-015 or VG1); or Australian/New Zealand Standards (AS/NZ 3838 or ARB HS 2012); or Snell Equestrian Standard 2001.

Safety Vest Guidelines

Per MN §7877.0170, Subp. 11 (B);

The safety vest must comply with one of the following minimum standards or later revisions: (A) British Equestrian Trade Association (BETA):2000 Level 1; (B) Euro Norm (EN) 13158:2000 Level 1; (C) American Society for Testing and Materials (ASTM) F2681-08 or F1937; (D) Shoe and Allied Trade Research Association (SATRA) Jockey Vest Document M6 Issue 3; and (E) Australian Racing Board (ARB) Standard 1,1998.

Riding Crops & Other Racing Equipment

In accordance with Minnesota Administrative Rules Chapter 7883.0170:

1. No bridle shall weigh more than two pounds.
2. All riding crops are subject to inspection and approval by the Stewards and the Clerk of Scales and shall fall under the specifications as provided within Minnesota Administrative Rules Chapter 7883.0170.
3. No person may use a chain shank to lead a horse unless the portion in the horse's mouth is covered with a soft, non-abrasive material.
4. No electrical, battery operated or solar powered devices may be used on a horse within 48 hours prior to the race in which the horse was entered.

Toe Grabs and Traction Devices

For Thoroughbreds, the HISA horseshoe rule is in effect for training and racing. On dirt surfaces, traction devices other than full rims two millimeters or less in height from the ground surface of the horseshoe are prohibited on forelimb horseshoes. Traction devices other than full rims four millimeters or less in height from the ground surface of the horseshoe or toe grabs four millimeters or less in height from the ground surface of the horseshoe are prohibited on hindlimb horseshoes.

On the turf, traction devices are prohibited on forelimb and hindlimb horseshoes. For more information regarding traction devices, visit hisaus.org.

For Quarter Horses, toe grabs other than wear plates with a height no greater than four millimeters (0.15748 inches) including bends, jar caulks, stickers and any other traction device worn on the front of shoes of horses while racing or training are prohibited. Toe grabs greater than 6.35 millimeters (0.25 inches) from the ground surface side of the hind shoes are prohibited.

Minnesota Racing Commission Claiming Procedures

1. Licensed Horse Owners

An individual who has a valid license as a horse owner - even though he or she may not at the present time own a race horse registered to race - may claim.

2. Unlicensed Individuals

An individual who desires to become an owner of a race horse through claiming may request a Claim Certificate from the Stewards by the following method: Submit a completed application for a horse owner's license to the Minnesota Racing Commission at the meeting where the claim will be made. The application must indicate the breed of the horse to be claimed and must state "to be claimed". The application must have the name of a licensed trainer who will be responsible for the care of the claimed horse. In addition to the application, a completed fingerprint card and payment for the license are required.

Restrictions on Claimed Horses

1. Claims shall be made in writing on a form provided by the association. Claims shall be signed and sealed in an envelope provided by the association and that envelope must be submitted and time stamped by the association not less than 15 minutes prior to post time of the race in which the horse to be claimed is entered.

2. A successful claimant may not transfer or sell a claimed horse (for racing purposes) for a period of 30 days. The racing association may demand that the horse be removed from the grounds and the association is not obligated to continue to provide such horse stall space on its grounds.

3. Claimed horses shall race at the track claimed. No claimed horse shall race at any other racetrack until the last overnight race of the meeting for the breed at which it was claimed has been drawn or for 60 days except to fulfill one or more stakes engagements or by the request of the Racing Secretary and approval of the Stewards.

4. A Claim Certificate is valid only at the race meeting where issued and is valid for the term indicated on the Certificate by the Stewards.

5. Horses must be claimed in accordance with full registered ownership. If there are two or more owners of a horse through which a claim is made, all must be included in the claim and so recorded thereon.

6. Determination of the true sex of a claimed horse shall be the sole responsibility of the claimant and mistakes in that regard printed in the official program or elsewhere shall not be considered basis for invalidating the claim.

7. Claimed horses may run back for any claiming price in their next start.

8. A post-race drug test shall be conducted on all claimed horses. A successful claimant may request to void the claim if the test demonstrates a medication violation under chapter 7890.

9. All claimed horses will be kept in the detention barn for one hour after the conclusion of the race. A claim will be voided if the horse dies or is euthanized within one hour of racing or the horse is placed on the Veterinarian's List for a musculoskeletal injury or unsoundness of heart or lungs within one hour of racing.

Minnesota Racing Commission Licensing

Applications for annual occupational licenses shall be accompanied by a non-refundable fee according to the following schedule:

1. \$100 - Veterinarian, bloodstock agent or vendor
2. \$50 - Owner, trainer, farrier or partnership
3. \$35 - Jockey, apprentice jockey or jockey agent
4. \$20 - Exercise person
5. \$15 - Pony person
6. \$10 - Hot walker or groom

Minnesota rule requires all applicants who have not previously been licensed by the commission to submit fingerprints with their initial application.

All applicants previously licensed by the commission must submit fingerprints every 60 months.

Trainer Employee Lists

Trainers are responsible for seeing that all their employees hold valid Minnesota Racing Commission licenses. Under the rules and regulations of the Minnesota Racing Commission, all participants in racing - officials, owners, trainers, jockeys, stable hands, etc., as well as pari-mutuel operators - are required to be licensed to serve in their respective capacities.

Each trainer must provide a list of all persons in his or her employment to the Stewards and the Association's Security Staff. The MRC must ensure that those persons are licensed by the Commission no later than the next racing day after those employees arrive on the grounds of an association. Employee List forms will be available at the stable gate. Trainers are required to keep these lists current. Upon discharge of an employee, the trainer shall report that fact to the Association's Security Office and Stewards by no later than the end of that day.

Worker's Compensation

All horsepersons racing at Canterbury Park are required to have a valid certificate of insurance for worker's compensation covering stable employees. This includes exercise riders that are not independent contractors. If they are deemed independent contractors they must meet the requirements set by MN statute 5224.0330 and 5224.0340.

Pony Rider & Groom Attire

All pony riders must wear a securely fastened helmet and safety vest and approved jackets or clean white shirts, clean blue jeans and use Canterbury Park saddletowels and helmet covers while on the racetrack during racing hours. These items will be available for purchase in the Racing Office.

Pony riders will be expected to keep their mounts well-groomed and their tack clean.

Grooms will be provided with numbered vests as they enter the receiving barn which must be worn when with their horse in the paddock and the walking ring.

Juveniles in the Canterbury Park Stable Area

1. All people under the age of 18 who do not hold a current Minnesota Racing Commission (MRC) license and are employed in the Stable Area or are not signed in by a legal parent or guardian through the Stable Gate Visitors Log must obtain a dependent's credential from the Security Department. In order to obtain the dependent credentials, a parent or legal guardian must accompany the dependent and sign for the credential, whereby the parent or legal guardian accepts full responsibility for the dependent, relative to the rules set forth by the MRC and policies set forth by Canterbury Park.
2. People under the age of 16 will not be allowed to operate any motor vehicle (including golf carts, motorized scooters, etc.) on Canterbury Park property.
3. Substantial penalties will be levied against any MRC Licensee who employs a person under the age of 16 or who employs people without a valid MRC License.
4. Substantial penalties will be levied against any parent or legal guardian who, after an investigative process, has been determined to be neglectful of said dependent.

Dogs in the Stable Area

No dogs will be allowed overnight in the stable area during the 2026 Racing Season. Permission to bring dogs in the stable area will need to be requested through the Stall Superintendent and can be rescinded at any time by Canterbury Park management for any reason.

Unlicensed Employees in the Stable Area

Any owner or trainer employing unlicensed individuals will be held completely responsible for all medical bills incurred by such help as a result of an accident at Canterbury Park.

Any owner or trainer employing unlicensed help is subject to disciplinary action by the Minnesota Racing Commission.

Parking in the Stable Area

Individuals who receive parking tickets and/or moving violation(s) on the grounds of Canterbury Park may be subject to the temporary or permanent forfeiture of driving privileges in the Stable Area.

All licensed persons wishing to operate a motor vehicle in the Stable Area:

1. Must obtain, from the Stable Gate, a parking permit that must be visible at all times from outside of the vehicle.
2. All persons operating motor vehicles on the grounds of Canterbury Park are required to hold a valid driver's license & auto insurance policy and be able to show proof of insurance.

House Rules & General Rules of Occupancy

Canterbury Park reserves the right to regulate by House Rule. Copies of each House Rule can be obtained from the Steward's Office or the Racing Secretary's Office.

Exclusive Rights Vested in Canterbury Park

Canterbury Park reserves for itself the exclusive right and sole discretion to enter, modify, alter or change the physical condition or use of any of its facilities, wherever located on or about its premises; permission granted herein to the Licensee to use the premises does not constitute a lease of the premises and Canterbury Park maintains the sole interest in and exclusive control of the premises.

Applicable Rules & Regulations

The license and privilege to reside at Canterbury Park granted hereunder is subject to and shall be governed by the conditions, rules and regulations of Canterbury Park as contained in the Dormitory Agreement and as set forth in its House Rules, Condition Books, Overnight Sheets or other materials published and disseminated by Canterbury Park or posted in the Racing Secretary's Office, HBPA Office or in any other Canterbury Park publication. Rules and Regulations are subject to change from time to time and any changes shall be deemed effective when made.

Dormitory Revocation

Residency in a dormitory room at Canterbury Park is **a revocable privilege** at the sole and exclusive discretion of Canterbury Park. Possession of a firearm in a dormitory room is strictly prohibited. Revocation of Dormitory Privileges may also include exclusion from all Canterbury Park property.

Dormitory Inspections

As a means of ensuring a safe environment within the stable area, periodic inspections will be conducted by track personnel of dormitory rooms at Canterbury Park. Failure to cooperate with a dormitory room inspection may be cause for immediate revocation of dormitory room privileges.

Fire Safety

The Licensee entering upon this agreement acknowledges having read and understood the Fire Prevention Regulations of Canterbury Park. Failure to follow the regulations or to not allow any safety inspection may be cause for immediate revocation of the licensee's dormitory room. Upon the request of the Shakopee City Fire Marshall, any dormitory or building on Canterbury Park property may be inspected. All city and state electrical codes must be followed at all times.

Canterbury Park Code of Conduct

Canterbury Park is committed to providing a safe environment as indicated in our Code of Conduct. No trainer shall be permitted stall space without acknowledging, in writing, their acceptance of the Canterbury Park Code of Conduct.

Training Schedules and Regulations

Training hours and a break schedule are available in the Racing Office and HBPA Office.

Any person mounted on a horse or working as a member of the starting gate team must wear both a securely fastened safety helmet and safety vest on the race track at all times. Safety equipment must match the standards set forth in MN §7877.0170, Subp. 11.

Horses galloping on the track at less than a two-minute clip will be required to stay 25 feet from the inside rail.

An ambulance staffed with an EMT or Paramedic, as well as a horse ambulance will be available during training hours.

There will be outriders on the track for your protection. Please do not hesitate to call the outrider if you need assistance.

Trainers, owners and all others must stand behind the rail or in the viewing area and NOT on the track surface.

Starting Gate Schooling

The starting gate is available for schooling on select mornings during workouts. Schooling hours to be announced.

Paddock Schooling

Permission to school in the paddock must be obtained from the Paddock Judge. The Paddock Judge can be reached through the Racing Office.

Paddock Entrance

Paddock entrance is restricted to owners, their guests, trainers, their guests and their employees and those involved with the conduct of racing at Canterbury Park. Any others wishing access or entrance to the Paddock area must receive prior approval from the Racing Secretary, Stewards, or Canterbury Park Management. No food, drink or strollers are permitted in the paddock at any time.

Stall Cleaning

Trainers are asked to make sure that the stalls allotted to them for the meet are clean upon vacating the backside at the end of season.

A minimum \$10 fee will be charged for stalls not stripped.

Change of Equipment & Gate Card

All trainers who request a change of blinkers must first secure a card from the starter.

A change of blinker equipment must be reported to the Racing Secretary's office at time of entry.

All horses which have never started must have approval from the starter before entry will be accepted. Gate approval is valid for 60 days.

All horses must carry their equipment to the post.
