INCIDENTS/INQUIRIES/OBJECTIONS:

The Stewards posted the Objection sign following the 4TH Race at the request of Jockey Eduardo Gallardo who rode second place finisher #3 "ANN LEE". Gallardo alleged interference from the first-place finisher #7 "HATTIE BLOOM" and Jockey Manuel Americano in the final 1/16. The films show that, although #7 did tighten the gap, #3 always had running room had his horse not dropped back at that point. Accordingly, no change was warranted.

The Stewards posted the objection sign Following the 6TH race as there were two Jockey objections filed. In the first incident, Jockey John Jude, aboard the seventh place finisher, #5 "TIGER FANTASY", alleged interference from the second place finisher #6 #WON CYBER LADY" and Jockey Constantino Roman at the ½ mile pole. The films shown that #6 did brush with #5 as the rider steadied, however, the incident in no way cost #5 the 23+ lengths that he was beaten at the end. No change was warranted.

In the second incident, Jockey Betty Williams, who rode the fifth place finisher #8 "AVOS ROSE", alleged interference from #7 "COPPER VIXEN" and Jockey Alonso Quinonez at the 1/16 pole. The films of the race support that #7 did drift out substantially and bump #8 out into #6 causing #8 to lose stride and momentum and the opportunity at a better placing. For that action, #7 was disqualified from fourth and place fifth behind #8 in a unanimous decision.

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the 7TH race to evaluate observed interference between the winner #3 "MIRACLE MULA" with Jockey Constantion Roman aboard and the second place finisher #4 "WOODSON" with jockey Manuel Americano. The films substantiate that #3 came out under left handed urging and carried #4 out costing the latter the opportunity at a better placing. Accordingly, the Stewards disqualified #3 from first and placed them second in a unanimous decision.

All of the above named Jockeys were placed on the film review list for next Thursday and will explain their actions at that time.
