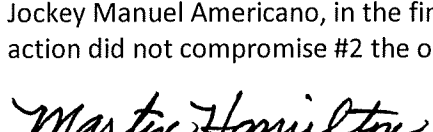
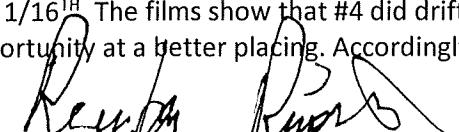
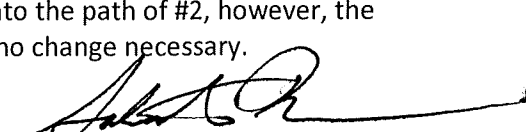

INCIDENTS/INQUIRIES/OBJECTIONS:

The Stewards posted the Inquiry sign following the 4TH Race to evaluate observed interference between the first place finisher #1 "GO LEROY GO" ridden by Jockey Manuel Americano, the second place finisher #5 'STRIKE COMMANDER' and Jockey Eduardo Gallardo and third place finisher #4 "MY GOSH' with Jose Riquelme in the irons. The films reflect that #1 drifted in, as #5 drifted out and together took the path of #4, causing that one to check his mount thereby costing them the opportunity at a better placing. Accordingly, both #1 and #5 were disqualified from first and second place, respectively, in a double disqualification.

The Stewards posted the objection sign following the 6TH Race at the request of Jockey Luis Fuentes aboard the third place finisher #2 "NORTHERN ANGEL". Fuentes alleged interference from the winner, #4 "TIKIHUT" and Jockey Manuel Americano, in the final 1/16TH. The films show that #4 did drift into the path of #2, however, the action did not compromise #2 the opportunity at a better placing. Accordingly, no change necessary.
